

Preventing the spread of COVID-19

Social Distancing & Hygiene

To prevent the spread of COVID-19, our business commits to practising good social distancing and good hygiene measures on our sites. The following principles have been adopted at this workplace:

PROVIDE HYGIENE FACILITIES BY:

- Providing adequate cleaning products and facilities for all employees and visitors.
- Implementing regular handwashing schedules.
- Cleaning any shared tools/ plant before and after each use.
- Providing PPE including gloves, masks, eye protection.

KEEP EVERYONE UP-TO-DATE ON THE LATEST INFORMATION BY:

- Sending regular emails and text messages with updates or changes.
- Providing signage about good hygiene and social distancing.

PROTECT OUR CLIENTS/COLLEAGUES BY:

- Confirming who will be at the premises before attending.
- Requesting confirmation that no one at the premises is unwell, been overseas recently, in quarantine or in self-isolation.
- Avoiding physical contact with other employees or vistors (eg. no handshake greetings).

FOLLOW ISOLATION RULES BY:

- Employees that are feeling unwell should stay at home.
- Any person returning from overseas or interstate should self-isolate for a 14 day period. If no symptoms show after a 14 day period, they can return to work.
 Anyone in contact with someone confirmed to have COVID-19 should self-isolate. If no symptoms show after a 14 day period, they can return to work.

• Advising staff of any potential risk of virus i.e. if an employee has been diagnosed or has been in contact with the virus.

PRACTISE SOCIAL DISTANCING BY:

- Keeping a minimum of 1.5m of separation.
- Limiting access to the site to only essential workers.
- Applying the 1 person per 4 square metre rule.
- Limiting any external visitors or third parties.

MINIMISE NUMBERS OF PEOPLE ON-SITE BY:

- Scheduling of sub-contractors/suppliers.
- Staggering of start and finishing times for workers when appropriate.
- Staggering of meal and other breaks.

FACILITATE CONTACTLESS DELIVERIES & PICKUPS AND PAYMENT BY:

- Allowing payments by direct debit, over the phone or contactless credit card.
- Use of photo evidence to receipt deliveries of materials to maintain social distancing.
- Pickups to be coordinated by phone to avoid multiple vehicles on site with documentation to be attached to the goods with photo evidence of collection.
